CANDIA STUDENTS — GRADES K-8

1. **All school Delayed Openings are for two hours.** Should this occur, students can be expected to be picked up at their bus stops **2 hours** later than normally scheduled. For example, if your child is normally picked up at 7:50 AM, on a delayed opening the pick-up time will be 9:50 AM.
2. Should students be **sent home early** due to inclement weather, announcements will be made on the same radio and television stations and students will be afforded the opportunity to call home.

In order to insure the smoothest possible efforts in dealing with inclement weather, please proceed according to the following guidelines:

School Cancellation or Delayed Opening announcements will be made on the following:

There will be no high school transportation should school be cancelled in Candia.

CANDIA STUDENTS ATTENDING PINKERTON ACADEMY

1. Should the **Delayed Opening procedure be in effect in Candia, but not at Pinkerton Academy**, high school transportation will be 90 minutes later than normal to Pinkerton.
2. Should the **Delayed Opening procedure be in effect at Pinkerton Academy, but not in Candia**, Pinkerton transportation will be 90 minutes later.
3. Should the **Delayed Opening procedure be in effect at Pinkerton Academy and in Candia**, high school transportation will be 90 minutes later than normal.
4. **Should there be a Delayed Opening at Candia and Pinkerton, Moore School** transportation will be two (2) hours later; Pinkerton transportation will be 90 minutes later.

CANDIA STUDENTS ATTENDING MANCHESTER HIGH SCHOOLS

1. Should the **Delayed Opening procedure be in effect in Candia, but not in Manchester**, high school transportation will be two (2) hours later than normal to Manchester.
2. Should the **Delayed Opening procedure be in effect in Manchester, but not in Candia**, high school transportation will be delayed by three (3) hours.
3. **Should there be a Delayed Opening at Candia and Manchester**, transportation will be two (2) hours later for both.

Should students in the **Candia Moore School be sent home early, but not at either high school**, arrangements will be made to provide high school students with transportation by school bus from that school prior to the Candia closing. Students in the high schools will be notified through the high school intercom system.
