### MAP Accelerator

The Moore School is piloting MAP Accelerator this spring. MAP Accelerator is a personalized learning tool for grades 3-8. Student NWEA MAP Growth scores in mathematics are used to automatically generate learning pathways in Khan Academy. These pathways include lessons, instructional videos, and practice problems. Teachers have the ability to adjust learning pathways as they see fit to further challenge or support students. This program is designed to support unfinished learning, on-track learning and advanced learning. Moore School teachers in grades 3-8 were trained in late April and will begin utilizing it with students the week of May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
