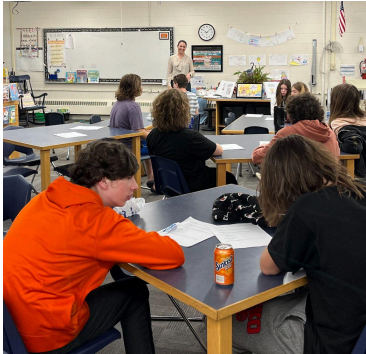

### Drama Performance

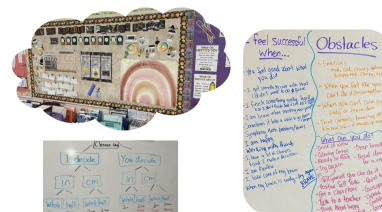

## HMS Summer School Camp 2024

## Program Approval and General Supervision (PAGS) Monitoring Process

Our student services team has completed the first two stages of the Office of Training and Monitoring (OTM) Program Approval and General Supervision (PAGS) process. Recently, staff from the NHDOE came to review some files. During this time, all of the staff commented on how impressed they were with how student Individual Education Plans (IEPS) were written with a strengths-based focus on what students can do and what the next steps in their learning would be. As part of this process, the Parent Information Center is hosting the listening session for Candia School District families and caregivers of students receiving special education tonight via zoom. This listening session information was shared with eligible families via e-mail and it was advertised by the NHDOE. Soon we will receive the PAGS findings to be reviewed by our team. We will notify them of any errors and will have an opportunity to provide any additional documentation that they require. In July, the district will receive their finalized findings that will inform the district of areas of success and areas for improvement.
