Dear Parent/Guardian,

Each year, New Hampshire public schools are required by state law (RSA 193-C) and federal accountability laws (Every Student Succeeds Act) to assess students using a standardized assessment. As you may recall, students took the writing portion of this assessment in early March. Beginning next week, students in grades 3 through 8 will participate in the remaining portions of the New Hampshire Statewide Assessment System (NHSAS).

Statewide assessments:

- Provide an evaluation of student mastery of content and skills in various academic areas
- Serve as one tool for measuring the degree to which students are on track to graduate high school and be college- and career-ready
- Help inform future instruction in the classroom

Along with student work on classroom assignments, projects and assessments, statewide summative assessment results provide teachers and parents with information about where students are on their path toward academic success.

Testing times for the NHSAS assessments average about an hour; however, students have additional time if needed. Results for the NHSAS (reading/writing, mathematics and science) are generally available soon after completion of the test. More information regarding how to access your child's results will be sent in the coming weeks.

It is helpful if you make sure that your child gets a good night's rest the evening before and a nice healthy breakfast that day of the assessment.
